Our Charitable Purpose

- **Advancement** of
 - education, arts, culture, heritage and sciences.
 - community development, including rural or urban regeneration.
- **Promotion** of
 - civic responsibility or voluntary work.
 - religious and racial harmony, and harmonious community relations.
- **Integration** of those who are disadvantaged, and promotion of their full participation, in society.

Our Charitable Purpose (cont.)

- Assisting with **humanitarian efforts**, including purchase and distribution of medical and humanitarian aid in Ireland and abroad.
- Providing efficient **shelter** for civil families affected by emergencies.
- Other purpose that is of benefit to the our **community**.



Our main objective

The main objective of AURI is to provide support for the **educational, cultural, humanitarian** and **medical** needs of Ukrainians living in the Republic of Ireland and abroad, and also, the **unifying** of Ukrainians and facilitation of their **integration** into the Irish society.



Our objectives

Include:

- Facilitation and **support** of ethnic identity and culture of Ukrainians living in Ireland.
- Providing support for Ukrainians and other people **interested in Ukraine** and its heritage; encouraging **participation** in social and cultural-related events. Help and support for Ukrainian migrants in **integration** into the Irish multinational community.



Our objectives (cont.)

- Founding and maintaining the **Ukrainian Cultural Centre** and **Ukrainian School** to preserve and develop Ukrainian language, culture and education.
- **Interaction** with other ethical (national) Associations/Societies in Ireland and abroad. Representation of the Ukrainian community in public, cultural, political and media institutions.
- Establishing **Ukrainian Irish Business Hub** in Ireland.
- Collection, purchase and distribution of **humanitarian and medical aid** for the Ukrainians and other communities in need.
- Assisting local authorities in finding and **providing safe shelter** for those in need.



Our goal

As the Ukrainian organization in Ireland we

- give a very **strong platform** for working with the **Government**
- **assist refugees** arriving here
- provide a **central point of contact** for many issues, counseling, healthcare, schooling, jobs etc.

Our approach

- Enlisting the support of other **professionals** e.g. childcare, education, construction etc.
- Generating **publicity** for the Ukrainian cause, both in Ukraine and for refugees in Ireland.
- Liaising with the **embassy** and its officials in Dublin and all Ireland to help build relations.
- Future planning for refugees, **Ukrainian Village** etc.
- Generating the support and **donations** of large companies and high net worth individuals.



Our challenges

Due to rapid growth of Ukrainian community in Ireland and high demand of our services

- Crafting a **masterplan** for the organization, including communication/media, PR and fundraising.
- Obtaining **legal support** ,providing **tech support** for volunteers
- **Financing** highly skilled dedicated project managers and admin staff.
- Fostering of **Ukrainian-Irish relations**.
- Establishing Ukrainian-Irish **Business Hub**.
- Fostering Ukraine-Ireland relations via hosting a series of events to **bring people together**.

We focus on:

Short-term:

- Immediate need – **information** provision, **accommodation** and **jobs**.
- **Adaptation** of new arrivals: informing, advising, legal support, short term housing.
- Access to **education** and schools.
- Trauma supports - providing **physical** and **mental** wellbeing supports for refugees.
- **Community** - maintaining a sense of community and identity during a traumatic experience.

Our focus:

Middle to long term:

- **Integration** - language skills, social security, education, access to training and employment, recognition of qualifications, assistance with employment.
- **Housing** - helping build new homes for the people who wish to remain in Ireland.
- Assisting Ukrainians to start their **own businesses**, which will turn them from subsidies into taxpayers and create additional jobs.
- Assistance in **self-organisation** of Ukrainians on the basis of local AURI branches.

The outcome

Natural facilitation and **integration** of temporarily displaced Ukrainians into multicultural Irish society as productive **economically valuable members of society**.

The task ahead of us is enormous, but achievable, with the support of the Irish people.

Our achievements

- **Medical Help Ukraine** Project - *GoFundMe* campaign to fundraise for medical equipment and supply.
- **“Palyanytsya”** - our Ukrainians hubs over the country.
- Collected over **€1,000,000 of** donations.
- Purchased generators, **medical equipment** and supply, evacuation transport and **ambulances** for Ukraine.
- Organised number of cultural and **fundraising events** all over Ireland (concerts, cake sales, sport days, etc)



In financial terms:

24 February 2022 - 16 June 2022

Irish people helped Ukrainians for

€1,342,082

- During this period donors transferred to our bank accounts total of **€316,930** (excluding GoFundMe campaign)
- AURI received equivalent of **€266,000** in donation of goods and services
- **€759,152** on the *GoFundMe* platform as part of Medical Help Ukraine campaign.

Our achievements in financial terms:


From February 24, 2022 to 16 June, 2022 Irish people helped Ukraine for **€ 1,342,082**:

- During this period donors transferred to our bank accounts total of **€ 316,930** (excluding *GoFundMe* campaign),
- The Association also received equivalent of **€ 266,000** in donation of goods and services
- **€ 759,152** on the *GoFundMe* platform as part of Medical Help Ukraine campaign.

for the period from 24/02/2022 to 16/06/2022


Total donations **€1,342,082**

Total expenses, €1,111,378





Administrative and governance costs


for the period from 24/02/2022 to 16/06/2022

for the period from 24/02/2022 to 16/06/2022




Total donations **€909,389**






Total donations
